

Returning to the Auditorium

(19 July 2021)

"I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD." (Ps 122:1)

With the easing of restrictions, the church will return to the RELC Auditorium for our worship services wef 1 August 2021. We will continue to have three services, all to be held in the Auditorium.

There will be two English services, one at 8am for non-vaccinated members (max 50) and another at 11am for vaccinated members (more than 50).

The 8am service is strictly for non-vaccinated members without the need for PET (pre-event testing). Vaccinated members are encouraged to attend the 11am service. Non-vaccinated members who wish to attend the 11am service must undergo a PET on their own to certify that they are COVID-19 negative.

PET through the Antigen Rapid Test (ART) can be done at SATA CommHealth for \$28 (<https://www.sata.com.sg/covid-19-antigen-rapid-test-art>) or any clinics provided in this list on Ministry of Health's (MOH) website: https://www.moh.gov.sg/docs/librariesprovider5/covid19_test_providers/approved-covid-19-art-swab-provider13jul.pdf (cost might differ).

The Chinese Service will be held at 9.30am (limited to just 50 pax) and can be attended by vaccinated as well as non-vaccinated Chinese-speaking members without the need for a PET.

Please know that "Vaccinated" means "that the individual has completed the full vaccination regimen in Singapore by the administration of an approved vaccine (i.e. the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine) by a recognised vaccination provider **and** has had sufficient time to develop sufficient protection (i.e. two weeks or more have passed after the second dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine) or is a recovered individual who has had one dose of an approved vaccination by a recognised vaccination provider (i.e. the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine) **and** has had sufficient time to develop sufficient protection (i.e. two weeks or more have passed after the dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine)."

Registration for the services will open on 25 July 2021 at 3pm.

Live streaming of the English and Chinese services will continue for those who cannot make it to the services.
